AGE-RELATED HEARING LOSS

Age-related hearing loss, also referred to as Presbycusis, is a hearing loss that is caused by degeneration of the hearing organ over time. It is common that this hearing loss gradually occurs in most adults as they grow older through wear and tear and is one of the four leading chronic health conditions experienced by the senior population in Australia.

This hearing loss typically affects both ears equally and it progresses from the high pitches of sound to low pitches of sound with ageing. Presbycusis most commonly impacts on high pitches of speech sounds which greatly impairs an individual's ability to understand speech. This degradation in the ability to understand speech becomes even more challenging in noisy and reverberant environments like cafes and restaurants. Tinnitus has also been associated with hearing loss. This is because as hearing sensitivity decreases, the perception of a ringing or buzzing noise can become more noticeable to the individual. Although age-related hearing loss is not a life-threatening condition, it can still have a significant impact on an individual's quality of life if it is left unmanaged and untreated. It can cause people to withdraw from social situations or limit interactions with family and friends without even noticing that it has to do with their hearing. This can lead to loneliness, isolation or depression as the individual stops communicating with people around them.

It is important to remember that hearing cannot be restored once it is lost. So be aware of potential sources of damaging noise such as loud music, power tools and firearms. Ensure that you are wearing earplugs or earmuffs if you are exposed to these sounds.

Age related hearing loss happens slowly over time and often people are not aware of the change at first. It is important to have regular hearing assessments to understand if your hearing is slowly deteriorating over time.

Common signs that this hearing loss may be affecting you, include finding speech sounds to be muffled and having more difficulty understanding words, especially when there is background noise. Adults with Presbycusis often find that they are straining to hear conversation and they need to use more effort than normal to listen when there is background noise. This can often make people feel tired or fatigued as they are concentrating more than ever to hear. It is also common to find yourself asking people to repeat or rephrase themselves more and more. Often it is a person's significant other or family that notice that the volume of the television or radio are slowly being made louder over time.

The arrival of spring brings a renewed sense of growth and vibrancy and as winter fades, our gardens begin to reflect the lively spirit of the season. Our friends at Sydney's Plant Market are here to provide any assistance and advice that you need to embrace our favourite season of the year!

CLASSIC SPRING BLOOMS:

At the forefront of spring blooms is the reliable Wattle (Acacia), with its distinct golden flowers. Following closely is the Boronia, notable for its pink or brown blossoms and pleasant fragrance. And for our Hills residents, the streets are often lined with the sweet pink flowers of the well-love cherry blossom.

DIVERSITY IN SPRING PLANTING:

For those looking to diversify their gardens, several colourful options bloom in spring. The Kangaroo Paw offers both colour and an attraction for local birds. The Waratah, with its robust red flowers, is an unmistakable Australian native. Or you might favour the variety of blue hues Delphiniums display or the dash of purple that the Hardenbergia introduces. Azaleas, with their striking bursts of pink (or other colours) provide a vibrant addition. And if you could bottle up spring, it would smell like Jasmine which will climb beautifully through your space.

TIPS FOR PLANTING SPRING BLOOMS:

- Soil Prep: Ensure the soil is well-aerated and enriched with necessary nutrients using compost.
- Spacing: Allow adequate space between plants to facilitate growth and proper air circulation.
- Depth: Planting depth is crucial. Typically, it should be around twice the size of the bulb or the root ball of seedlings.
- Watering: Water sufficiently post-planting to settle the soil and roots, eliminating potential air gaps.

CARING FOR YOUR SPRING BLOOMS:

The Dural Brigade and other brigades in the district are conducting a number of hazard reduction burns (HRs), most recently on Quarry Rd.

- Prepare your home and get it ready for bushfire season;



It was a special privilege to represent Hornsby Shire on Veteran's Day. The occasion marked the 50th Anniversary of Australia's involvement in the Vietnam War, and with the day itself, (18th August), marking the anniversary of the Battle of Long Tan in 1966.



In addition, to the Hornsby service in Railway Park, a local service was held at the recently refurbished cenotaph in Glenorie's Wal Buckingham Park. Joined by RSL subbranch members and Hills Deputy Mayor, Mitchel Blue, a fitting memorial was delivered for the 60 000 Australian service personnel that served over a 10-and-a-half-year period and recognising the 523 lives lost and the 3000 wounded.

Importantly, it was a reminder of how the declining support for the war resulted in the poor treatment of our returning veterans. This should never occur again. With the cenotaph now

restored, it is also fitting that the next stage of the park plan will now be rolled out. Improvements to paving, landscaping, furniture etc. will be features of proposed work. The eventual plan being an overall precinct upgrade from the Bus terminus to the Memorial Hall.

More welcome news this month included the State Government back down on changes to rural land use. Much of last years proposed changes increased opportunities for rural landowners to value-add to their existing activities. However, one change relating to visitor numbers on farm, has now been revised to remove the numbers cap. This has been a long journey and testament to the community and Government agencies working together for common-sense outcomes. We look forward to our remaining rural businesses enjoying the opportunity to share farmgate experiences with the public.

PREPARE FOR THE BUSHFIRE DANGER PERIOD

The Greater Sydney Bushfire Danger period commences on **1st October**. To prepare for this bushfire season I strongly encourage all residents, landowners and businesses to prioritise their bushfire preparedness. We have been very lucky in the past 20 years to have had no major bushfires in Hornsby area, and after several very wet summers, I have noticed a concerning level of complacency amongst many in the community.

The Hornsby local government area is the Bushland Shire which we all love. However, because of this we will always be exposed to the risk of bushfire. The upcoming summer will bring an escalated potential risk in our region due to increasing bushfire fuel levels.

To assist with protecting lives and property the RFS emphasise the need for residents to plan and prepare themselves, and their property for the upcoming summer. To support these efforts, they are holding their annual state-wide 'Get Ready Weekend' on **16th and 17th September**. This aims to provide the community an opportunity to connect with their local brigades to discuss their specific bushfire risks. The event underlines the significance of individual responsibility to create bushfire resilience.

In addition to the Get Ready Weekend, many local RFS brigades are holding street meetings that connect long-time and new residents with local firefighters. These gatherings intend to facilitate detailed discussions about the risks, consequences and steps residents must take to prepare for the impact of bushfires. Aimed at raising awareness and motivating early pre-emptive measures, these RFS events are designed to engage, inform and change behaviour in the community.
